


- Pre-registration is required for all children and an additional fee of \$55 per day is charged for those not enrolled in the School's Closed payment plan. Payment is due with the registration form.

- **If your child has a life-threatening health condition that requires an EpiPen(R), Benadryl(R), or rescue inhaler we must have those items brought to the School's Closed program site along with a medication order form that has been completed by a physician. We cannot bring the medication from the program that your child normally attends.**
- Please note: lunches must either be in a heavy paper bag or plastic grocery bag — no regular lunch boxes.
